**Leadership Pathway.** The leadership pathway provides the flexibility to develop competencies *within* or *across* the 6 core track areas depending on experience, interests and skills members want to develop.

- **Introductory** - involvement in entry level volunteer activities that offer members opportunity to acquire general knowledge/skills along the core track areas to support issues affecting the HCQP community.
- **Intermediate** - involvement in volunteer activities that offer members opportunity, along the core track areas to acquire practical application of leadership skills to guide or direct group learning within HCQP community.
- **Advanced** - involvement in volunteer activities that offer members opportunity along the core track areas to acquire comprehensive leadership skills that support broader alliances between state/national HCQP professional communities.
